Our Commitment

GP Liaison Services Ltd is a UK-based specialist consultancy providing data analytics, operational improvement, and information governance services to NHS pathology and diagnostics organisations. We are committed to minimising the environmental impact of our business, to complying with all applicable environmental legislation, and to supporting the NHS in its own commitment to reach Net Zero. We have committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2045, ahead of the UK Government's 2050 target, and we will publish and annually update a Carbon Reduction Plan prepared in accordance with PPN 06/21 setting out our emissions, targets, and progress.

How We Operate

Our environmental impact is structurally low, and we keep it that way by design: we deliver client engagements remotely by default, travelling only where on-site presence adds clear value; we apply a travel hierarchy of remote first, then rail, then shared road transport, and we undertake no domestic air travel; our sole company vehicle is fully electric; we operate as a fully paperless business, producing and issuing all deliverables digitally; we host our cloud services with Amazon Web Services in the EU (London) region, benefiting from AWS's published commitment to renewable energy; and we minimise waste and purchase responsibly across our small supplier base, preferring providers with published environmental and Net Zero commitments.

Environmental Management System

The Board has formally committed to implementing an environmental management system aligned to ISO 14001 and has commenced the adoption process. This policy is the foundation of that system. As part of implementation, we will: maintain a register of our environmental aspects, impacts, and applicable legal requirements; set objectives and review performance against them at least annually; measure and report our emissions through our Carbon Reduction Plan; and embed environmental considerations into the delivery of every client engagement.

Responsibility and Review

The Managing Director holds Board-level responsibility for this policy and for environmental performance. All staff and subcontractors are made aware of this policy and are expected to work in accordance with it. This policy is reviewed and republished at least annually.
